



New 6,000 Square Foot Rehabilitation Center Opens at Medford Multicare Center

After successfully caring for and providing rehabilitation to thousands of residents over the past 12 years, Medford Multicare Center celebrates the opening of their new, 6,000 square foot Rehab Center.

“The Rehab Center was designed with our residents in mind,” said Karim Nensey, Director of Rehabilitation at Medford Multicare. “We have designed a unique place for residents who require short-term rehabilitation that offers every comfort and amenity,” said Karim.

The rehabilitation center has been expanded to encompass a large 6,000 sq. ft area where physical, occupational and speech therapy are provided. It is equipped with the newest technology in the market including the OmniVR™ Virtual Rehabilitation System, Litegait for those who have difficulty standing or walking to alleviate a fear of falling, virtual reality treadmills with screens that simulate cross country settings to motivate residents, and more.

A primary function of a rehabilitation center is to help people regain independence in self-care activities of daily living that may have been lost after an illness or stroke, including eating, dressing, and bathing. Medford Multicare Center not only has provided a space for retraining of activities of daily living in the new rehabilitation center, but has constructed an actual full-size apartment to simulate what a person encounters during daily life at home. Also inside the new Rehab Center: Medford Multicare Center’s custom PT Cruiser where residents can re-learn how to transfer in and out of an automobile, Giella’s Market place that simulates a shopping experience, and a mini-golf course and shuffle board court that provide residents additional opportunities to regain and increase range of motion, mobility and endurance.

“It is important for us to provide a real-life experience for our residents during their recovery, and our new Rehab Center will do just that,” said Karim. “Our goal is to assist our residents to regain their maximum level of function and enable their return home after regaining their highest level of independence possible,” he said.
